Dear Parent/Guardian of Boyceville Science Olympiad Student:

First, thank you for all of your support this past year of the Science Olympiad program! In particular, thank you to all of you who volunteered at either of our hosted tournaments or any of our away tournaments. Our students' success is not possible without all of your help.

This summer will be the 5th Annual Boyceville Science Olympiad Golf Outing on Saturday, July 13th at the Menomonie Golf and Country Club. The format is a scramble, or four-person best ball (each person hits their drive, then the best shot is selected and all four hit from that location, and so on). This is one of the most important fundraisers for Boyceville Science Olympiad. Last year we raised over \$3000 through this fundraiser, and the money raised helps pay for the following:

- Hotel Costs at Belleville MS & HS Invite (last year around \$1300)
- Registration Fees for all Invitational Competitions for MS & HS (last year \$1500)
- Transportation to Ohio (last year around \$5600)
- Hotel Costs in Ohio (last year around \$3500)
- Build event supplies, including balsa wood, glue, rubber, plane supplies, mousetrap vehicle supplies, Mission Possible supplies, roller coaster supplies, AMA Alpha Kits, Glider kits, Wright Stuff kits, 3D printer filament, and other supplies
- GPS devices for Geocaching

While there is a cost for students to attend the invitational in Ohio (\$30 per student), this fundraised money allows us to keep overall costs down. Next year we are hoping to tour the Henry Ford Museum in Detroit, MI on our way to Solon, OH for our Friday activity. As a reminder, all students who participated in the state tournament this past year are eligible to go with the team to the Solon (OH) Invitational Tournament next year.

If every family were able to secure one team or one hole sponsor for this year's golf tournament, we would more than double last year's fundraised amount. Please consider helping in any way you can.

I have attached an information and registration form. There are several ways to participate, even if you aren't a golfer. Consider asking businesses for hole sponsorships and/or raffle items. ***Students who secure sponsorships/donations will receive prizes including team apparel price deductions next fall, depending on the amount secured.***

We will also be looking for volunteers on the day of the golf outing to sell raffle tickets, run hole event games, and help in general. You can sign up with Mr. Hamm if you are interested and available.

If you are interested in golfing, you can either sign up an entire team or any number of people and we will fill teams the day of the tournament. The more golfers we can get to sign up, the better the tournament, so please spread the word. ***All golfers who participate will receive a gift bag as well as lunch after the tournament, a great value for only \$25!***
